- Perform pre quality inspections on all orders and work with Quality Control to resolve any quality related issues
- Maintain relationships with existing workshops and suppliers to ensure delivery dates and quality are achievable
- Work with the stock controller to ensure stock levels remain accurate and sufficient
- Approve high value invoices in a timely manner
- Provide Finance with accurate timesheets monthly

- Ensure machinery and equipment are operated and maintained to maximise utilisation
- Prepare the workshops for client visits
- Provide estimated cost for bespoke projects
